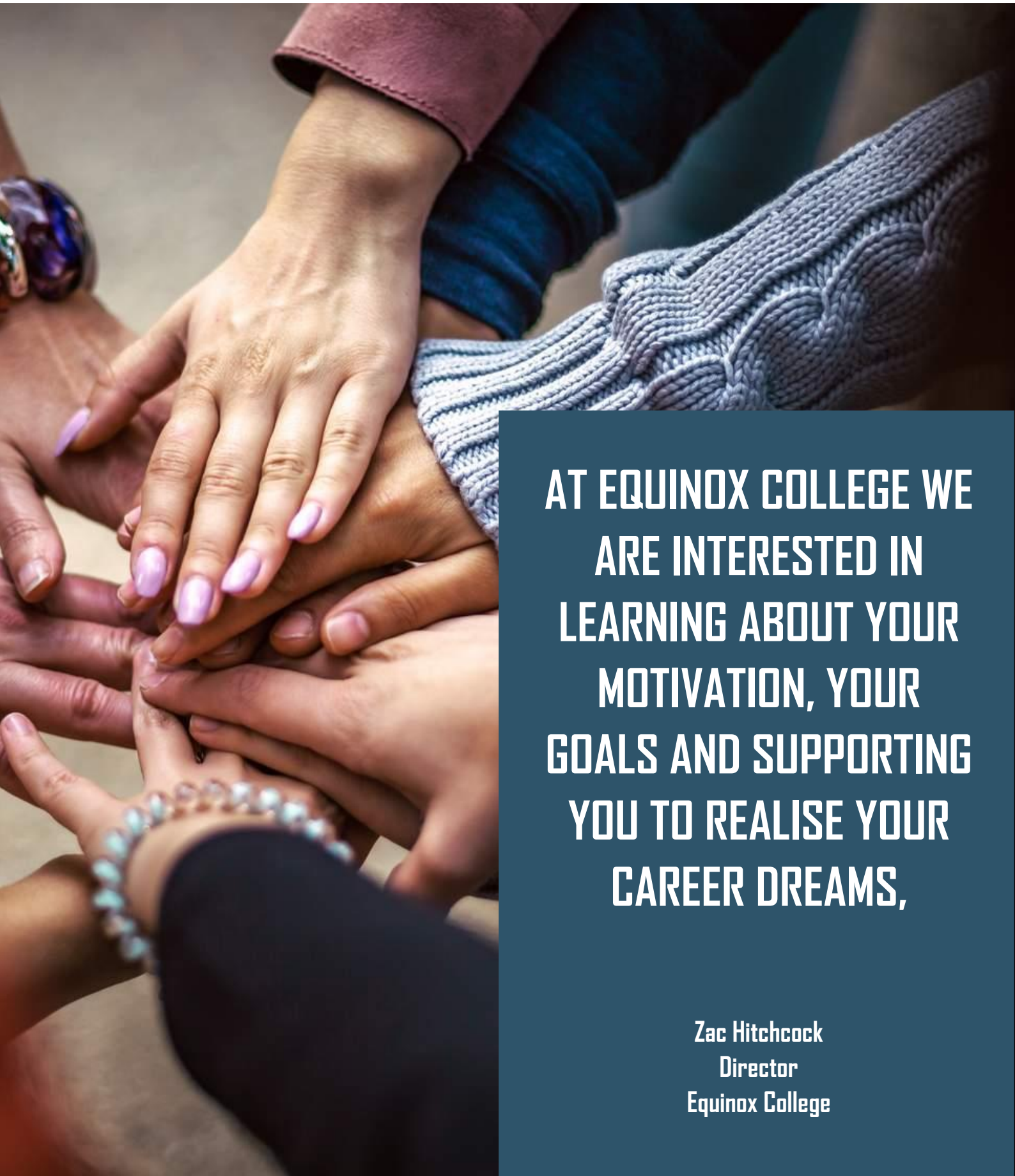

## ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

We recommend that you:

- Have current recent experience in a supervisory role within a Disability Support Service
- Have a Certificate III or higher in a community services related qualification

The 11076NAT Diploma of Leadership in Disability Services will provide you with the skills and knowledge to lead a high performing team, deliver effective services to NDIS participants, and contribute to the growth of your organisation.

This qualification has been designed in consultation with industry to support the career development of experienced and emerging leaders in the disability services sector.

You will have specialised skills in Disability Services leadership and a sound understanding of the complex financial framework in the NDIS. You may also have responsibility for the supervision of other workers and volunteers and/or case management, program coordination or the development of new business opportunities.

This program is available: Online (learn@home) and Recognised Prior Learning (RPL).

Our online program is delivered over 18 months, where you will meet with your trainer monthly via live webinars and coaching, to discuss the topic and assessment requirements. A high level of self-direct learning is required by students.

You will be required to demonstrate the practical assessment requirements in your workplace, via video or physical evidence.

## CAREER OUTCOMES

### SUPPORT COORDINATOR

A Support Coordinator in the NDIS assists participants in developing and managing their plans, connecting with services, and adjusting support as needs change. They play a key role in monitoring service effectiveness, resolving crises, and empowering participants to make decisions, enhancing their independence and quality of life.

### DISABILITY SERVICES MANAGER

A Disability Services Manager in Australia's NDIS oversees service delivery, ensures compliance with standards, leads teams, engages with participants for plan development, liaises with stakeholders, and manages budgets. This role is crucial for empowering individuals with disabilities to achieve their goals and integrate into the community.

### GOVERNMENT AGENCIES

Working in local, state, or federal government departments that focus on disability services and policy implementation.

### NON-PROFIT ORGANISATIONS

Engaging with charities and NGOs that provide support and advocacy for people with disabilities.

### PRIVATE DISABILITY SERVICES

Roles in private companies that specialize in disability services, or in firms as part of their diversity and inclusion initiatives.

### VOCATIONAL EDUCATION

Provide training and assessment services to those wishing to enter the sector.

### CONSULTANCY AND ADVISORY ROLES

Providing expert advice and consultancy services in the field of disability services management.

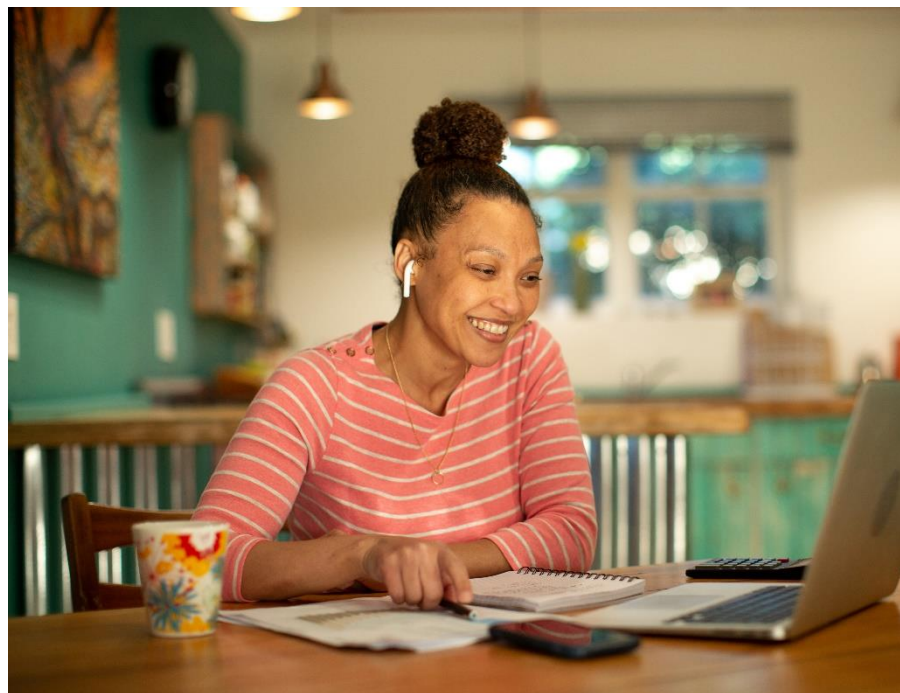

# IT REQUIREMENTS

- Basic computer skills
- Knowledge of common computing terms and word processing
- Proficiency with web browser software including navigating the internet

## TECHNOLOGY REQUIREMENTS

### Operating system

- Recommended: Windows 10, MacOS Big Sur, iPad OS 14

### Internet speed

- Use a broadband connection through USB wireless modem, ADSL2+, T1/T2, fibre optic or cable with the speed:
  - Viewing lecture recordings or conferencing - at least 5MB/sec
  - Viewing images and webpages - at least 2MB/sec

### Internet browsers

- Compatible browsers include:
- Google Chrome 8x or later (recommended for optimal compatibility, this has been thoroughly tested on Windows)
- Safari 14 or later (recommended for optimal compatibility, this has been thoroughly tested on Mac)
