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ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

There are no academic requirements for this course.

Successful applicants will need to:

- Achieve a level of language, literacy, and numeracy appropriate for a Certificate III course.
- Be able to handle physical aspects of the role.
- Be emotionally equipped to handle the role.
- Have a passion for caring for the elderly
- Be at least 18 years of age or older.

ABOUT THIS QUALIFICATION

This qualification reflects the role of individuals in the community, home or residential care setting who work under supervision and delegation as a part of a multi-disciplinary team, following an individualised plan to provide person-centred support to people who may require support due to ageing, disability or some other reason.

These individuals take responsibility for their own outputs within the scope of their job role and delegation. Workers have a range of factual, technical and procedural knowledge, as well as some theoretical knowledge of the concepts and practices required to provide person-centred support.

The skills in this qualification must be applied in accordance with Commonwealth and State/Territory legislation, Australian standards and industry codes of practice.

To achieve this qualification, the candidate must have completed at least 120 hours of work as detailed in the Assessment Requirements of the units of competency.

Minimum of **120 hours** of direct support work.

Placement: Aged Care Organisation

Your Workplace Integrated Learning (WIL) is an essential component of the full qualification and will be undertaken in Australia in an approved aged care service.

NOTE: Workplace Integrated Learning is only required as part of the Stage 3 program During your studies in Individual Support, you are required to complete a **minimum of 120 hours** of direct support work in an Aged Care organisation (Host Organisation)

This is called a Workplace Integrated Learning (WIL),

WIL is an integral part of the course, giving you the opportunity to apply your skills and knowledge in the workplace.

All students will be placed at a Host Organisation where you will work alongside and under the direct supervision of a buddy, undertaking the day-to-day duties required of a worker at this level.

We organise 3-weeks blocks of WIL throughout the year, and all are located in the Moreton Bay Region of QLD.

If you will be locating to another part of Australia, we recommend that you enrol with a local provide to complete your training.

For all Equinox College International sourced WIL, you will be required to work an 8-hour shift at a residential aged care service with usually a half an hour lunch break to ensure you meet the requirements of 120 hours of placement.

You will be required to commence shifts sometime between 6am and 7am (this is at the discretion of the host organisation), some facilities offer students an option of an afternoon shift, sometimes ending between the hours of 10pm and 11pm.

Again, WIL days and shift times are always at the discretion of the host facility and Equinox College International supports the host facility in these directives.
